ABOUT THE PROJECT

The GBS - Empowering Senior citizens' self-employment in Green Business project aims to motivate senior citizens to take up self-employment in Green Business in order to improve their socio-economic inclusion and well-being. To achieve this main goal, the partnership will work on creating a set of OERs to motivate senior citizens to take part in the green transition and will develop a digital pedagogical Toolkit, which will be supported by pedagogical implementation methodologies for adult educators to facilitate digitally reinforced mentoring sessions.



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The project's GBS objectives are:

- to motivate Senior citizens for self-employment in the Green Business;
- to create flexible digitally-reinforced mentoring learning pathway to develop Seniors' knowledge and skills to start Green Business as a part of their entrepreneurial competence;
- to ensure recognition of obtained by learners competences by developing digital assessment tool;
- to enhance the capacity of adult educators to effectively facilitate the e-Studio.



NEXT STEPS OF GBS PROJECT

Set of OERs for motivation of Senior citizens “Green Business: is it my way to go?” through:

- the development of a presentation for self-learning on possibilities and challenges;
- the development of a set of storytelling-based success stories as role models of successful self-employment;
- the development of a set of good practices from media resources to provide opportunities for learners to analyse success of senior citizens in green businesses and identify themselves within self-employment in some types of those businesses;
- the development of an interactive game „My personal skills and strengths to start Green Business – how to develop them” to identify senior learners' knowledge on green business and indicate skills needed further development;
- the development of an e-Guide “Learning through the mentoring process “Growing my competences to start a Green Business”” for learners to motivate them to further participate in the digitally-reinforced mentoring.
